Currently there are vacancies on the following board-appointed groups:

Board of Social Services: Supervises the administration of the Gloucester Department of Social Services to assure the development of services that promote economic and social self-sufficiency; provide protection and support for families, adults, and children; and assure that available resources are used in efficient and effective ways.

Clean Community Committee: Serves in an advisory capacity to the Board of Supervisors and county staff on matters related to county beautification efforts, litter prevention, collection and disposal of solid waste, recycling, and environmental education.

Telecommunications Committee: Serves in an advisory capacity to county administration. The committee will work with staff to review and advise on issues related to cable services, telecommunications, broadband, local telecommunication infrastructure and help promote local government and school public programming on public access channels.
